

# Phase out PFAS Firefighting Foams

## Switch to PFAS-free Class B

Many fire departments are switching to PFAS-free AFFF for Class B fires.

Look for **GreenScreen Certified** products or contact DEC at [afff@dec.ny.gov](mailto:afff@dec.ny.gov).

**Read the label.** It might contain PFAS if it lists: Fluoro, C6, C8, C10, or C12 chemicals, Light water, Class B AR-AFFF.



## Stage PFAS foam for disposal

Store 5-gallon pails on shelves or pallets.  
Label them **Do Not Use**.  
Store indoors above 32 degrees F.



## Why?

PFAS are toxins. They can accumulate in blood and can contaminate drinking water supplies and soils.
